## CLAYTON OPERA HOUSE <br> STAGE \& WING AREA 2009



- The Clayton Opera House was built in 1903 and has a raked stage with a run/rise ratio of $18 / 1$ or for every 18 " of run you have 1 " of rise. Example: $3^{\prime}$ or $36^{\prime \prime}$ of run equals 2 " of rise. The total run of the stage is $22^{\prime}$ with a rise of $15^{\prime \prime}$.
- The playable area is 22 feet deep and 27 feet wide. ( $27^{\prime}$ between the support poles.)
- Front of Stage to Plaster Line is 32 inches.
- The Proscenium opening is 25 feet 8 inches wide.
- The distance between the structural columns on stage is 27 feet.
- The distance from the back wall to the structural columns is 10 feet 2 inches.
- The wings are 13 feet wide.
- Stage Left wing has a high ceiling.
- Stage Right has a enclosed air duct and electronics that limits the height to 10 feet.
- Stage Right has 11 - Three Phase outlets (L21-20R) located on a wall 10 feet above the stage deck. ( 6 currently used)
- Stage Right has 3-5 pin DMX outlets located on a wall 10 feet above the stage deck. (3 currently used)
- Stage Right has a Quad Edison outlet located under the breaker panels and a 2 Edison outlet along the back wall.
- Center Stage back wall has a 2 Edison outlet located under the air duct.
- Stage Left has no power outlets. (Power can be run from the Green Room or from the Front of the Stage if needed)
- All curtains are Black in color and Dead Hung. (See Line Set)

2 Travellers - Main (Draw DSR) and Rear (Draw USL)
4 Borders
4 sets of Legs (Legs can move along a 5 foot track as well as pivot)

- Exits to Front of House are located on both sides of the stage. A set of stairs can be placed off the front of the stage.
- Exits to the Green Room and Dressing Rooms are located on both sides of the stage.
- Crossover space between the rear traveller and the back wall is 3 feet. NOTE: HEADSPACE LIMITED TO 6 FEET.
- Crossovers can be made through the Green Room.
- Dressing Rooms (2) are located on the Second Floor and assessable by using the stairs located off the Green Room.
- Each Dressing Room has it's own sink, closet and a well lit make-up table.
- Dressing Rooms share a common rest room and shower. You must provide your own towels and soap.
- Dressing Rooms share a common iron, ironing board and hair dryer.
- Dressing Rooms share a Dorm sized refrigerator. (Unstocked)
- There are NO laundry services located in the building. A laundromat is located on the same block.
- A lift is available from street level to the stage for those in need of assistance.
