Foxtrot and Samba Class at the Clayton Opera House

The second hour will be devoted to “open” dancing according to a 10 dance sequence printed on a program and available to all. Singles are always welcome.

Future dates and dances to be taught are: March 12, Cha-Cha and West Coast Swing and April 16, Tango and Hustle.
