***Cha-Cha and West Coast Swing at the Clayton Opera House***

Clayton, NY – TIPAF at the Clayton Opera House continues its popular monthly ballroom dance classes with the next session scheduled for Friday, March 12 for dancers of all levels. The two hour dance session runs from 7:00 to 9:00 pm and will consist of one hour of instruction and one hour of open dancing. Advance registration is not required and the cost is \$10 per person. Professional dancers Doug and Bonnie Johnston will be leading the lessons and open dance.

This month the Cha-Cha and West Coast Swing will be featured. The first hour of the session will always be for instruction beginning with thirty minutes for beginners in one dance (this week the Cha-Cha) and ending with thirty minutes of intermediate to advanced patterns in a second, different dance (West Coast Swing). The second hour will be devoted to “open” dancing according to a 10-dance sequence printed on a program and available to all. Singles are always welcome.

There’s only one more lesson remaining in the 2009-2010 series, which is scheduled for Friday, April 16. The Tango and the Hustle will be featured.

With this program, the Clayton Opera House expands the “public participation” aspect of its performing arts offerings to rival those in locations
