***Learn to Tango and Hustle at the Clayton Opera House***

Clayton, NY – TIPAF at the Clayton Opera House presents the final class of the 2009-2010 ballroom dance series on Friday, April 16th. Dancers of all levels are welcome to attend the two-hour dance session that runs from 7:00 to 9:00 pm and features one hour of instruction in the Tango and the Hustle, followed by an hour of open dancing. Advance registration is not required and the cost is \$10 per person. Professional dancers Doug and Bonnie Johnston will be leading the lessons and open dance.
